

Simple Steps to Accreditation



I want to become an Accredited Partner, what do I need to do?

The following steps detail what needs to happen in order for you to achieve and maintain accredited status. Requirements differ depending on whether you have successfully completed the Institute of Sound and Communication Engineers (ISCE) certified course-'Design and Installation of induction loop systems'.

Step 1- Completion of company and *individual profile Questions

To help market your business and promote your accreditation with us, we will create a profile for your company and the nominated *individual(s) responsible for the overseeing of loop installations. To do this, we need you to provide information by answering the questions on page 4 and 5 and either e-mailing or posting the answers to us.

You will also need to provide us with your logo.

When you have achieved accredited status, your profile will appear on our website. Reciprocal links will be organised at this point.

Step-2 Training

If you HAVE completed the ISCE certified course 'Design and installation of induction loop systems' please skip to step 3

You will need to successfully complete our 1 day induction loop installer training course. These are held throughout the year at different locations.

Training can be offered at company locations where a number of people from the same organisation wish to attend. **Now go to step 5**

Step 3- Proof of successful completion of ISCE certified course

You will need to provide us with a copy of the certificate for the individual(s) within your company who have successfully completed the ISCE certified course.

Step 4-Your introduction to UnivoxAudio and our new loop design software

As you have already trained with the ISCE, you **do not** need to attend our training course. You will only need to meet with us for a personal introduction and training in the use of 'Designaloop'- our new loop design software. Once trained we will carry out an inspection of one of your customer approved induction loop installations made with Univox® equipment. If your installation is approved you will receive accredited partner status.

Step 5- Completing your first Univox® installation

You will have a period of **9 months** from the date of attending either our training course or, if ICSE trained, our software training, to complete your first Univox[®] induction loop installation. During this time you will:

- Have full access to the new Univox[®] loop design software—'Designaloop'
- Receive a generous discount on all UnivoxAudio retail prices
- Receive help, advice and support whenever you need it (On going)

At the earliest opportunity we will carry out an inspection of an installation. If this is approved you will receive 'Accredited Partner Status' and you will appear on our website. In the unlikely event that your installation is not approved, we will advise and recommend on what action needs to be taken to gain approval.

How do I maintain my Accredited Partner Status?

Step -6 Annual partner review

Part of the accredited partner programme includes an annual partner meeting. This includes:

- A review of the partnership
- Development of strategies for business growth
- Advice and help on any technical matters
- Exploring ways to support you further
- Addressing any issues important to you
- Details from you of 3 customer approved induction loop installations

Step-7 Two yearly inspection

Every 2 years we will inspect one of your installations.

Steps 6 and 7 are an on going process designed to help you get the most from our partnership as well as maintain your accredited status.
