







Analog Signal Input [Stereo]




AES Signal Input [Stereo]




DA Amplifier Signal Flow

Amplifier Control

AC Power On

After connecting the outputs to the loudspeakers, you may turn the amplifier on.

- 1. Make sure the output gain settings for all audio-source devices (CD Players, Mixers, Instruments, etc.) at the lowest output (max attenuation);
- 2. Connect Power Cord and turn the AC Mains power switch on the front of the amplifier to ON;
- 3. You can now bring up the outputs of your audio sources.

Volume Control

Rotate the encoder to adjust volume. This operation will simultaneous change the volume of channel A/B or C/D.

Input Signal Type Selection

After power off, use a small tool to press the button marked No.6 on rear panel. When the button is up, the channel will change to analog signal input; press down the button, the channel will change to AES signal input. The button marked No.6 on rear panel only will be available when the amplifier is power off.

Bridged Mode

After power off, use a small tool to press the button marked No.7 on rear panel. When the button is up, input mode will change to stereo mode; press down the button, input mode will change to bridged mode. The button marked No.7 on rear panel only will be available when the amplifier is power off.

Installation


The following steps are written in the recommended installation order.

Mount the DA Amplifier

The DA Series amplifiers are designed to be mounted in a standard rack-mount unit. The amplifiers are 2RU high, 290 mm (11.42 in) deep.



CAUTION!: Be sure that nothing is blocking the front or rear ventilation openings, and that each side has a minimum of 2 cm clearance.




1. Use the proper fastening hardware (not included) to secure the amplifier in the rack. The DA series amplifiers have two front mounting tabs.

AC Mains



WARNING!: When the AC Power is on, there is a potential of having dangerous voltage at the output terminals on the rear of the amplifier. Use caution not to touch these contacts. Turn off the AC Mains disconnect switch prior to making any connections.



The DA amplifiers have a Universal power supply 100 – 240 VAC, 50 – 60 Hz.

1. Connect AC cable between the amplifier rear AC connector and the AC source.





NOTE: When you remove power from the amplifier, then re-apply the power, the amplifier returns to its last state.






