




## **OVERVIEW**

## Transmitter

- 1. Antenna
- 2. Power/Signal indikator
- 3. LCD battery status
- 4. ICD channel lock
- 5. LCD selected channel
- 6. Aux-in socket
- 7. Up/Down button
- 8. Power button
- 9. Built-in microphone
- 10. Mic-in socket
- 11. Mute/Sync button
- 12. Lanyard tie-up



#### Power on/off

- Press and hold power button  $\Phi$  for 1 second to turn the transmitter on. LCD screen shows  $\Phi$  and then last used channel.
- Press and hold power button  $\bullet$  for 2 seconds to turn the transmitter off. LCD screen shows "OF" and then shuts down.

#### Channel lock/unlock

- Channel will automatically be locked and symbol " " shows up if the device is idle for 5 secons after being turned on.
- To unlock the channel, press buttons △ and ▽ simultaneously for 2 seconds until symbol " ≜ "disappers.

#### Channel selection

• Press button  $\triangle$  or  $\nabla$  to select preferred channel when channels are unlocked.

#### Sensitivity adjustment (transmitter only)

- When channel is looked, press and hold riangle for 2 seconds to enter mode  $m{u}$  .
- Press either button  $\triangle \nabla$  to adjust the sensitivity (Default:  $U5,U1 \sim U8$ ).
- Press power button **b** to confirm the setting.

# Mute/Sync

• When the mute button is pressed no sound reaches the microphone. Note that the mute button also is used for synchronization (see below).

## Receiver

- 1. Antenna
- 2. Power/Signal indikator
- 3. LCD battery status
- 4. LCD channel lock
- 5. LCD selected channel
- 6. Volume
- 7. Up/Down button
- 8. Power button
- 9. Earphone socket

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#### Power on/off

- Press and hold power button  $\bullet$  for 1 second to turn the receiver on. LCD screen shows  $\bullet$  and then last used channel.
- Press and hold power button  $\bullet$  for 2 seconds to turn the receiver off. LCD screen shows "OF" and then shuts down and the LCD turns black.

#### Power saving (receiver only)

Power of receivers will be off if no signal is received for 20 minutes.

# Transmitter and receiver channel syncronization

When synchronizing the units should not be more than one meter apart.

- Press mute/sync button on transmitterr before it is turned on.
- Turn the transmitter on and purple LED flashes to indicate the activation of channelsync mode.
- Turn receiver(s) on to be channel synchronized (one or multiple receivers can be turned on at the same time).
- When channel i successfully synchronized, receiver's LCD shows same channel as that
  of the transmitter and its LED turns steady blue.
- Press the transmitter's mute/sync button to exit sync setup. When the transmitter has left sync set up, the sound is turned off when the mute/sync button is pressed.

#### Note! If synchronization fails

- 1. Turn the transmitter off and repete above procedure to redo the synchronization.
- 2. If it still doesn't work, turn off the transmitter and receiver(s) and redo the synchronzation procedure again as described above.
